


## 2018 DEADLINE calendar

Key tax deadlines for individuals, including the self-employed without employees, estates and trusts.

**JAN** 16

Pay fourth installment of 2017 estimated taxes.



Tax season JAN kicks off. File 29 2017 income tax returns early to minimize the risk of tax identity theft.

W-2 JAN deadline 31 for household employers.

Report **FEB** January 12 2018 tip income to your employer.

**FEB** 15

File to claim exemption from federal income tax withholding for 2018.

Report MAR February 12 2018 tip income to your employer.

Report APR March 10 2018 tip income to your employer.

File (or APR extend) 17 your 2017 income tax return.

APR 17

Pay first installment of 2018 estimated taxes.

APR for **17** 

Pay taxes employing household workers in 2017.

APR 17

traditional IRAs or Roth IRAs for 2017. Contribute to SEPs for 2017 (unless you file an extension).

File FBARs for 2017. If you

miss the deadline for 2017 FBARs, it will automatically be extended until October 15.

File (or extend) 2017 gift tax returns.



File (or APR extend) 2017 17 income tax returns for estates and trusts with December 31 year



Report MAY April 10 2018 tip income to employers.

Report JUN May 11 2018 tip income to employers.

JUN 15



File (or extend) your 2017 income tax return if you live outside the United States.

JUN 15

Pay second installment of 2018 estimated taxes.

Report JUL June 10 2018 tip income to employers.

Report AUG July 10 2018 tip income to employers.
